The Missouri Historic Costume and Textile Collection

The Missouri Historic Costume and Textile Collection, established in 1967 by Carolyn Wingo, supports the teaching mission of the Department of Textile and Apparel Management. Faculty, staff, alumni, and friends of the University have donated over 7,000 garments, accessory items, household textile including quilts and coverlets, and ethnographic clothing and textiles. The collection continues to be used to support the mission of the Department of Textile and Apparel Management (TAM) to prepare students for professional positions in the apparel industry.

Items from the collection have been featured in exhibitions throughout the state of Missouri, but never to the extent of what will be featured at History's Closet event. This event will provide an exclusive viewing of over 70 items from the collection, many of which have not been showcased previously.
